THE MALDIVES

The famous explorer Marco Polo called the Maldives "Flower of the Indies" while the great traveler Ibn Batuta referred to her as "one of the wonders of the world".

Geography

The archipelago is 823 km long from North to South and 130 km at its greatest width. Any of the 1192 islands that are spread over 26 natural atolls exceed a length of 4.5 miles or an altitude of 6 feet above sea level. No more than 202 islands are inhabited. The rest includes 87 tourist resorts and uninhabited islands, some of which are used for drying fish or other agricultural activities.

A Brief History

While the early history of the Maldives is obscure, Maldivian legend has it that a Sinhalese prince - Koimale - was stranded with his bride - daughter of the king of Sri Lanka - in a Maldivian lagoon and stayed on to rule as the first sultan.

Over the centuries, the islands have been visited and their development influenced by sailors from countries on the Arabian Sea and the Indian Ocean littorals.

Mopla pirates from the Malabar Coast – present day Kerala - harassed the islands. In the 16th century, the Portuguese ruled the islands for 15 years (1558-1573) before being driven away by the warrior-patriot Muhammad Thakurufar Al-Azam.

Though governed as an independent Islamic sultanate for most of its history from 1153 to 1968, Maldives was a British protectorate from 1887 until 25th July 1965. The British government promised the Maldives military protection and non-interference in local administration in exchange for an annual tribute paid by the Maldives. In 1957 the British established a RAF base in the strategic southernmost atoll of Addu for £ 2000.00 a year.

Following independence from Britain in 1965, the sultanate continued to operate for another 3 years. On 11th November 1968, it was abolished and replaced by a republic and the country assumed its present name.

The People

The origins of "Dhivehin" (Maldivians), are shrouded in mystery. The first settlers may well have been from Sri Lanka and Southern India followed by, as some findings suggest, Aryans from Lothal in the Indus Valley about 4000 years ago. Not surprisingly, the faces of today's Maldivian display the features of various faces that inhabit the lands around the Indian Ocean shipping and maritime routes, the Maldives has long been a melting pot for African, Arab and South East Asian mariners.

Climate

The south-west monsoon or "hulhangu" from May to September is the wet season. Rough seas and strong winds are common during this period. The north-east monsoon "iruvai" falls between December to April. This is a period of clear skies, lower humidity and very little rain. The Maldives is in the equatorial belt and therefore severe storms and cyclones are extremely rare events.

Language and Script

The language of the Maldivians is Dhivehi, a language which is placed in the Indo-Indian group of languages. Dhivehi with its roots in Sanskrit and according to some researchers Elu, an ancient form of Sinhala (spoken in Sri Lanka) is strongly influenced by the major languages of the region. The language has been influenced heavily from Arabic since the advent of the Islam in 1153.

The Maldivian script known as Thaana was invented during the 16th century soon after the country was liberated from Portuguese rule. Unlike former scripts, Thaana is written from right to left. This was devised to accommodate Arabic words that are frequently used in Dhivehi. There are 24 letters in the Thaana alphabet.

THE GREEN PAGE

Global warming and rising sea levels have been of particular concern to the Maldives. To help us protect the fragile environment of the island, we urge you to follow these guidelines.

Please refrain from walking on corals for your own safety and to avoid harming the delicate reef system which protects the island and to preserve it for our future guests to enjoy its splendor.

Please do not catch fish either from the lagoon or the house reef. For the fishing enthusiasts, the hotel provides Big Game Fishing upon request. Please refer to excursion page No. 9 for details.

Please do not pick shells and corals, either dead or alive. Maldives customs will confiscate such items at Male' Airport.

We recommend any empty spray cans and used batteries be brought back with you for disposal, as these items are harmful to the environment and are not recyclable on the island.

In order to maintain a self-sustaining operation, the following infrastructure has been implemented for your convenience.

Water

All tap water in Mirihi is sourced from the sea and desalinated by reverse osmosis. It is perfectly safe brushing teeth but we recommend bottled water for drinking.

Electricity

Generated by 3 x 350 kva diesel generators with an output of 230 V – 50 Hz.

Sewerage

Sewerage is biologically treated on the island.

Fumigation

In an effort to keep the environment relatively insect-free, non toxic sprays are used on the island on a weekly basis. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

Being a small island with almost 200 people at peak capacity (guests and staff), a significant load is imposed on the above mentioned systems. We would greatly appreciate your cooperation by practicing the following.

- Switch off lighting and air conditioning units when not needed
- Conserve water by turning off taps when using soap or brushing your teeth
- Place towels you wish to have replaced into the basket/bag provided in your bathroom

INFORMATION

Check-In & Check-Out times

Check-in time at Mirihi is 14:00 hrs (Mirihi time) and check-out time is 12:00 hrs (Mirihi time).

In cases of evening departures, we will try our best to keep your villa at your disposal until the departure time, unless absolutely necessary.

Currency Exchange

Although billing is done in US-Dollars, most other foreign currencies can be exchanged at the Front Desk. You can also get a cash advance off your credit card with a 6% banking charge. Travelers Checks will be exchanged with a 1% banking charge.

Dress Code

We only request kindly that guests do not dine in bathing suits. Shorts and T-shirts with sleeves are acceptable in the restaurant. To abide by the laws of the government, we do not permit topless bathing and sunbathing.

Shoes are optional. Most of our guests walk barefoot throughout their entire stay.

Gratuities

Should you wish to leave a token to be shared by all members of the team, please use the tip box provided at the Front Desk. Upon your request, we could also add the required amount to your final bill which will be added to the tip box. You may also tip a particular member of the team personally.

Mirihi Team

To make sure your stay with us is an unforgettable experience, we have a team of 140 well trained local and international staff. Every member of our team will be delighted to be of any help should you request.

Mirihi Time

On Mirihi all timings are on island time which is one hour ahead of Male time.

Payments

Our guests are not required to carry any cash on the island. Whenever you make a purchase, you will be asked to sign a bill. Final bill will be presented to you the evening before your departure day.

Payments can be made by all major credit cards – like Visa, Master, Amex and JCB.

Traveler's Checks and cash are also accepted. You may also split the bill and pay in different modes.

On trips to local islands please take only cash (preferably US-Dollar or Maldivian Rufiya) as most currencies, TC and credit cards will not be accepted.

We can arrange flower bouquets to be brought from Male' on your request. Please keep us informed of such a request at least one day in advance.

Internet Access

You can find a guest computer in our lobby next to the boutique. Please contact Front Desk to buy a voucher. The costs for 15 minutes are USD 5.00.

Wi-Fi Internet

Wireless Lan is available at most areas of the island. Please refer to communications page No. 17 or to the information flyer in your room.

Lost and Found

The hotel shall not be held responsible for personal belongings left in your villa or public areas. However, we will do our utmost to help you find any item you may have misplaced.

Medical Assistance

A number of Mirihi team members are trained in First Aid procedures. First Aid kits are easily accessible on the island and on boats. The hotel does not have a resident doctor. However, should the need arise you may consult a doctor on a nearby island which can be reached in 25 minutes by speed boat.

Special Dining Arrangements

Whether you want to surprise your loved one with a romantic dinner on the tip of the island, have a feet-in-the-water breakfast, enjoy a bottle of Champagne while watching the last rays of the sun aboard our sailing yacht, we can tailor many special events. Only your imagination sets the limit!

Wake-up Calls

You may set an automatic wake-up call using the telephone in your villa by dialing 55 followed by time (e.g.: for a wakeup call at 07:30 hrs, dial 55 0730 and wait for a confirmation message). To cancel a wakeup call, dial 55 and hang up. Or you may also register a wake up call at our Front Desk.

HOUSEKEEPING

Air Conditioning

Your villa is air conditioned with remote control. For added comfort, you may wish to use the ceiling fan in your villa, which is operated by a switch located next to your bed. You are requested to kindly switch off the air-conditioner when the doors are left open.

CD Player

We have placed a Maldivian music CD in the CD player. Should you require changing the music, please collect your choice from a wide selection of music CDs available for free at the Front Desk. A total of 3 CDs at a time can be borrowed with no extra charges.

Espresso Machine

Two cups of Espresso and six cups of tea including 2 bottles of mineral water and a small milk carton are provided every day on complimentary basis.

Hair Dryer

A hair dryer is located in your dressing cabinet. Please use only the electrical socket closest to the dressing table to operate the hair dryer.

Laundry and Pressing

For laundry service please fill in the laundry form provided in the wardrobe and place it along with the items. Your villa attendant will take the bag to the laundry on his next visit. For express service please call Front Desk on "0". Please note that our services do not include dry cleaning.

Mini Bar

Every room is equipped with a Minibar with soft- and alcoholic drinks as well as a choice of snacks. Please inform yourself about prices on the price list.

Personal Safe

We recommend that all your valuables be kept in the personal safe located in your wardrobe and ensure that it is properly locked. The hotel will not be held responsible for loss of personal belongings in the villas.

Room Cleaning & Turn Down

Your villa attendant will visit you in the morning to clean your villa and in the evening to turn down. In case you like not to be disturbed by the attendant, please use the "Do Not Disturb" sign in front of your villa.

Please drop towels you wish to have replaced into the basket/bag under the sink in your bathroom. Towels left anywhere else will not be replaced with fresh ones.

Telephone

Snorkeling

Snorkeling is best on the northern side of the house reef. To rent snorkel gear please visit Ocean Pro Diving Center, open from 08:30 hrs to 08:50 hrs, 14:30 hrs to 14:50 hrs and from 18:00 hrs to 19:00 hrs.

A snorkeling safari to nearby two reefs on our sailing boat Mirihi Thari is organized weekly. Please refer to excursion information board in library.

We urge you to be cautious not to step on reefs or disturb its inhabitants.

Television

A television set with satellite channels is at the library near Boutique. Sports, movie and news channels are available.

Water Sports

If you feel like being more active, take one of our ocean kayaks and paddle around the island. We also have a complete range of windsurf gear available, suiting everyone from beginner to expert. The use of water sports equipment is available complimentary to all our guests.

Reservations and bookings

The excursions mentioned in the following can be booked by signing in on the booking sheet at the excursion board next to the guest internet computer and the boutique. There you find detailed information about the date and time of the excursion and the exact program points. If you can't find your requested favorite excursion, need further information or have problems in understanding please do not hesitate to contact either Guest Relations or Reception.

As we also offer all excursions or cruises on a private base, these won't be mentioned on the excursion board. Therefore we will charge you a different amount. If you are interested in one of those private trips, please feel free to contact Guest Relations for further assistance. Only your imagination sets the limit!

To organize an excursion please make sure you make the reservation at least one day in advance, so we can arrange everything required and can coordinate with other appointments.

Meeting point

For every excursion the meeting point will be at the reception shortly before the actual starting time.

Cancellation

If you want to cancel a trip please do so at latest at 19:00 hrs the previous day. In case of a delayed cancellation we will charge you 50%. Please understand that No Shows will be fully charged.

Kindly note that all excursions are considered based on the prevailing weather as well as ocean conditions in the lagoon and the outer reef region. In case of bad weather on the excursion date we will cancel the trip or try to postpone it without any cancellation fee.
